

Bill of Rights

1. Freedom of Religion, Speech, Press, Peaceful Assembly and Freedom of Petition to redress grievances to the government. (Five Freedoms)
2. Right to Bear Arms
3. Right to not have your home used to house soldiers in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by law. (Quartering of Soldiers)
4. Protection from illegal search and seizure of an individual's home & property
5. Protection against self-incrimination.
6. Right to a speedy and public jury trial in all criminal prosecutions
7. Right to a Civil jury trial in all matters over twenty dollars
8. Prevents excessive bail or cruel and unusual punishments be imposed.
9. Individual Rights not listed in the constitution or other rights
10. States Rights not listed in the Constitution are reserved for the states or the people.
